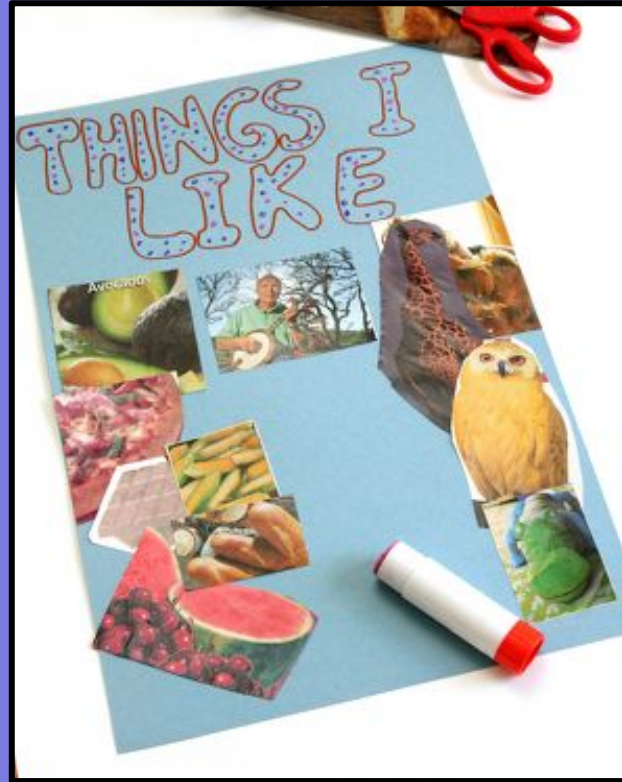
OPTION 1:

Make An All About Me Collage

Directions:

- 1.) Make a collage from magazines, newspaper, pictures found online, and drawings!
 - 2.) You should find pictures that, for example, represent your age, favorite color, favorite school subjects, favorite hobbies, favorite sports, favorite animal, favorite singers, favorite holidays, favorite foods, and more!
 - 3.) Find at least 7 pictures that represent you!
 - 4.) Glue or tape the pictures to a piece of construction paper.

OPTION 2:

Make A Family Star

Directions:

- 1.) Cut out a star for each of your family members on any type of paper.
- 2.) Write a talent your family member has on their star. You can also make a star for your friends. It's important that you understand other people's talents and what they are capable of.

Examples of talents you could write:

cooking, fast runner, dancer, sleeper, writer, speaker, etc.

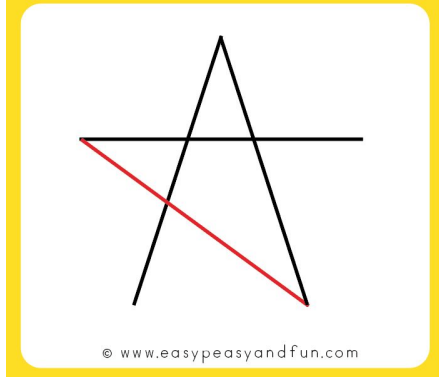

INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO DRAW A STAR:

STEP 1: Draw a letter A without the middle line.



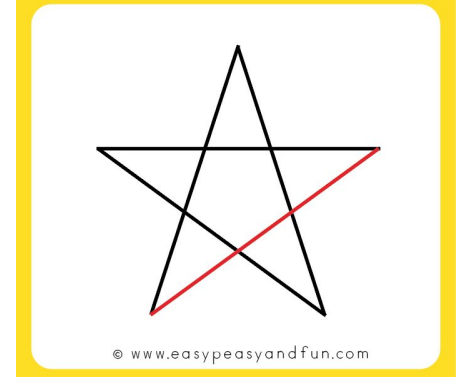
STEP 3: Draw a line connecting the sides.



STEP 2: Draw a straight line in the upper part of the "A".

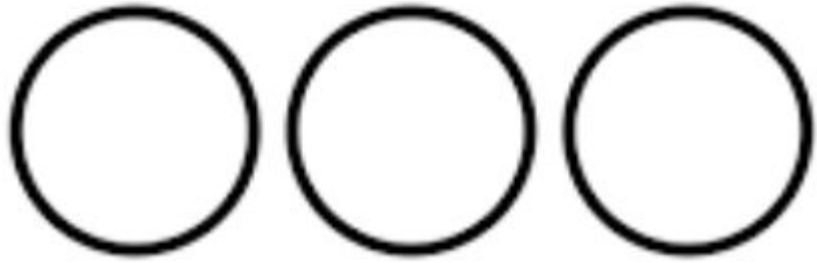


STEP 4: Then draw another line to connect the other sides. Your finished!

OPTION 1:

Circle Art

Materials: Printable Link, construction paper, crayons or markers, scissors, glue

Step 1:

- Start by printing out the link on the slide above, or if you do not have a printer trace out 4 different size circles using household items such as a cup.
- Then in the smallest circle have the girl draw themselves, and color it in, in the second circle have them draw whoever is the next most important person in their life.
- In the third largest circle, have them draw any other group of people that they interact with next.
- In the largest circle, have them draw the people that surround them in their communities, that they have not put in any of the other circles. Color in all of the circles however you like.

Step 2:

- Have them cut out each of the circles, and glue them in order from smallest to largest on the construction paper, the circles may have to overlap in order to fit on the paper. Now they have completed a circle map that shows that they are a part of a big community!

OPTION 1:

Make Face Masks for your family



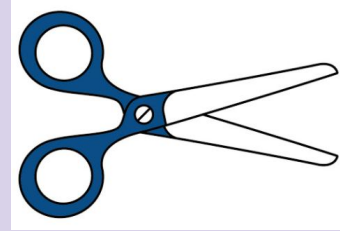
For this option, you will make an easy no sew mask!

Materials needed:

- At least an 18in X 18in piece of fabric (You could use a bandana or an old cotton t-shirt. The fabric can be bigger than 18in X 18in, but it shouldn't be smaller than this).
- 2 hair ties

STEP 1: CHOOSE FABRIC

For this project, you can either use a bandana, fabric from an old cotton t-shirt, or piece of cotton fabric. The bandana will not need to be cut up, but the t-shirt and fabric do.

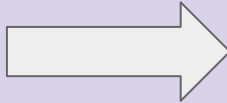


STEP 2: CUT FABRIC

If you are using a bandana, you do not need to cut up the fabric. If you are using an old t-shirt or fabric, you need to cut out at least an 18in X 18in square.

STEP 3: FOLD FABRIC

- Lay the fabric on a flat surface, face down.
- Fold the top of the fabric to the middle.
- Fold the bottom of the fabric to the middle.
- Fold the fabric in half again (top to bottom) so there are four layers of fabric in one long rectangle.



STEP 4: CREATE MASK

- Slip a hair tie onto each of the ends of the mask.
- Slide the hair ties a few inches towards the middle of the folded fabric.
- Fold the ends of the fabric to meet in the middle.
- You want the ends of the fabric to slightly overlap so you can tuck one end into the other.
- You should wear the mask with the smooth side facing out.



YOU SHOULD TRY TO MAKE AT LEAST 3 OF THESE FACE MASKS,
BUT YOU CAN MAKE LESS IF YOU DON'T HAVE ENOUGH
MATERIALS TO MAKE 3. YOU COULD GIVE THEM TO MEMBERS
OF YOUR FAMILY OR YOUR FRIENDS.

OPTION 2:

Make Kindness Rocks
