Step One: Hear a Story



You will earn this step by learning how YOU can make a change in the world! You only need to complete one of the options.

Option 1: Play a game from around the world

Activity Length: 15 Minutes

Materials Needed:

• For Escargot: Small squares of paper, Markers

& Masking tape





Option 1 Cont.

Steps:



- 1.) Girls all around the world like to play games. Playing games is a way to get to know others and active games are important for staying healthy and fit. By playing games and doing activities from around the world, we get to see what girls in other parts of the world like to do.
- **2.)** Play the game Escargot (Escargot is a version of hopscotch that children play in France).







- **1.)** Set up a snail pattern on the floor with masking tape and decide which foot is your hopping foot and who will go first. Whichever foot you choose is the foot you will hop on for the entire game.
- 2.) Hop through to the center on one foot. Start with square one. Hop only once in each square. Do not hop on any lines or a turn is lost.
- 3.) You may rest when you reach the center. Hop back to the beginning, following the same rules.

Option 1 Cont.

How to Play Escargot:



- **4.)** If a you hopped in and out successfully, you may choose a square as your "house." Put your initials in the square (write on small squares of papers and tape it in the square). You can use this space to rest and other players must skip over the square.
- **5.)** The game is over when it becomes impossible for anyone to hop to the center.

The player with the most squares at the end is the winner!

Recipe 1: Paletas or Mexican Style Ice Pops

Prep: 10 minutes

Freeze: 6 hours

Makes: 8 Ice Pops

Ingredients:

- 3 cups ripe, fresh fruit
- ½ cup sugar
- ⅓ cup water
- 3 tbsp lime juice
- Blender
- Popsicle Mold, or Cupcake Tin
- Popsicle Sticks



Steps:

- Place half of your fruit, the sugar, the water, and the lime juice in a blender and blend until smooth. You can also use a fork to mash the fruit if you don't have a blender.
- Pour this mixture into a popsicle mold. You can also pour the mixture into a cupcake tin or paper cups if you don't have access to a popsicle mold.
- Cut up the remainder of the fruit into small cubes, and place into the popsicle mold with with rest of the fruit mixture.
- Put the popsicles into the freezer. After and hour, place popsicle sticks into the molds, and freeze for 5 more hours or until solid.
- Enjoy!

Recipe 2: Creme de Abacate (Avocado dessert) from Brazil

Time: 20 minutes

Makes: 4 servings


Ingredients:

- 4 Ripe Avocados
- 1 can sweetened condensed milk
- 4 tablespoons heavy cream
- ½ cup powdered sugar
- 4 tablespoons lime juice,
- up to 5 (6) tablespoons lime zest, to decorate,
 (Optional)
- 4 tablespoons shredded coconut, to decorate, (Optional)



Steps:

- Cut your avocados in half, remove the seed, and scoop out the fruit into a bowl.
- Add the condensed milk, heavy cream, powdered sugar, and lime juice into the bowl.
- Mash all of the ingredients together until they are fully mixed
- Decorate with shredded coconut and lime zest to decorate (Optional)
- Enjoy!



Option 3: Connect a fairy tale to other stories in our own life.

Instructions:

- Choose a fairy tale that you know
- Brainstorm how the events in your chosen fairytale and connect how this story relates to your own life.
- Share with others what you found in this activity.



Option 2: Choose a picture and write a story to go along with the picture!

Option 3: Rescue Mission

This option is completed by going on a rescue mission to save some animals!

Material Needed: Stuffed animal or something similar, paper plates, and a blanket.





STEP 1: Lay the ship (blanket) out on the ground, stand on top of it. Place the stuffed animals and a few paper plates around the ship. OH NO, the ship has been hit by a large wave and has stopped working!

STEP 2: To save the ship, you must flip the blanket over (make the bottom of the blanket face the top) without stepping into the ocean (floor). And then you must rescue all of the animals by getting them all onto the blanket. Hint: you can use the plates as stepping stones in order to rescue the animals and flip the ship over. If you fall into the ocean (touch the floor) you must start again.

After the game, think about how it felt to save the animals. Was it hard? How did it feel to solve a problem?

Step 3: Tell a Story



You will earn this step by creating your own story! Throughout your day, think of ways you can help others! Tell your story by sharing with others how you can positively impact the lives of those around

Examples of what you can do to help others:

- Help cook dinner
- Help your parents with chores
- Clean your siblings room for them
- Make nice cards for you for your neighbors
- Plant a garden with pretty flowers for everyone to see

Brainstorm 3 more ways you can help others!

Step 4: Better World for Girls! Award

Your will earn this part of the journey by completing the All Camp Project! One of the examples on the previous slide about what you can do to create your own story, was to plant a pretty garden. Look to the next slide for further information.

This portion (step 4) of the journey is completed through the All Camp Project, making seed bombs, which will make pretty flowers when you throw them! By creating a pretty garden, you are helping others and the environment!
